

How to Add Tamil Language and Tamil 99 Keyboard in Windows 11

Step 1: Download & Install Keeladi Keyboard (Alternative Tamil 99 Tool)

1. Open your web browser and go to:
 <https://cceindia.in/tamil99>
2. Download the Keeladi Keyboard setup file.
3. Unzip the downloaded file.
4. Open the extracted folder and follow the installation instructions.
5. Navigate to the download folder, find the TAU-Marutham file, right-click it, and select Install.
6. Open the **Tamil99** folder, find the Setup file, right-click it, and select Open.
7. Follow the on-screen instructions and select Yes for all prompts to complete the installation.

Step 2: Add Tamil Language in Windows

1. Open Settings by right-clicking the Start button.
2. Go to Time & language → Language & region.
3. Click Add a language and search for Tamil or தமிழ்.
4. Select Tamil (India) and click Next → Install.

Step 3: Add Tamil 99 Keyboard

1. Click Options next to Tamil (India) in the language settings.
2. Under Keyboards, click Add a keyboard.
3. Select Tamil 99 from the list.

Step 4: Switch to Tamil Keyboard

1. Click the Language icon in the taskbar (bottom-right).
2. Select Tamil 99 Keyboard as your input method.

Step 5: Verify Keyboard & Start Typing

- Open Notepad or any text box and try typing in Tamil.
- Use Marutham (Unicode Font) for the best Tamil text display.
